

# The Palestinian American Women's Association Announces: THE RACHEL CORRIE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2020

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 27, 2020

The Palestinian American Women's Association (PAWA) of Southern California established the Rachel Corrie Scholarship (RCS) Program to commemorate the life of American peace activist Rachel Corrie. It is in her honor and legacy that PAWA hopes to inspire future activists.

The goal of RCS is to empower young female activists in becoming leaders in their community by cultivating their cultural and political understandings of Palestine. The Rachel Corrie Scholarship Program will act as a tool in broadening the scope of campus activism by linking the struggles of student activists in Palestine to local students in the United States.

RCS Requirements - RCS is open to young women who are: graduate or undergraduate students; at least 18 years of age; have completed two years of undergraduate coursework; previous experience in community organizing and/or campus activism; minimum GPA of 3.0; and must be available to travel to Palestine on or before June 8, 2020.

The selected recipient of RCS will be enrolled in the Palestine and Arabic Studies (PAS) Summer Program at the prestigious Birzeit University. The scholarship includes the cost of travel, enrollment fees, and housing. For more information on Birzeit's PAS Program, please visit: http://sites.birzeit.edu/pas/.

#### TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- RCS includes: enrollment at the Palestine and Arabic Studies (PAS) Program at Birzeit University; enrollment, application and processing fees; library fees; and living expenses for two months (shared-room)- placement is done through Birzeit University.
- RCS recipient must be able to travel to Palestine on or before June 8, 2020.
- Upon return from Birzeit, the award recipient will be expected to present her experiences and knowledge obtained while at Birzeit University.
- Recipient may be asked to participate and/or volunteer at any of PAWA's yearly events, including but not limited to: International Women's Day Banquet, Ramadan Iftar, and our Educational Series.
- The scholarship is not renewable and may only be awarded once per individual.
- The Rachel Corrie Scholarship recipient is required to have comprehensive travel medical insurance coverage for the entire length of the term program.

#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited university/college
- Someone dedicated to the Palestinian cause
- Application and personal statement saved in a Google Doc format, copy of transcripts and recent photo emailed to coordinator of RCS, (rcspawa@gmail.com).
- A list of two people who can provide a reference check
